PARABELT

Tourniquet Belt

PARABELT is a daily-wear utility belt with an integrated ratcheting tourniquet. For use as a tourniquet, PARABELT is intended to be wrapped around a patient's limb and tightened to reduce circulation and therefore control severe bleeding of the arms or legs.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:



1. Place belt around injured limb 2-3 fingers above wound, with ratchet facing out. Thread belt through buckle over sliding bar.



2. Release Velcro and insert thumb into loop. Pull on free end to tighten belt securely around



3. Lift lever arm of ratchet repeatedly to tighten tourniquet until bleeding stops. Record time of application. Seek immediate medical attention. Reassess the wound frequently: Additional tightening may be required.



4. Remove tourniquet by placing finger under tab marked "lift to open" and firmly pull upward and back to release. If tourniquet doesn't release, lift ratchet lever arm while pulling tab.

CARE & MAINTENANCE:

- · Hand wash and air dry only.
- · Keep tourniquet free of dirt and debris.
